As part of the National Centre for Geospatial Intelligence, No. 1 AIDU compiles and distributes Aeronautical Information to all MOD aviation assets as well as Partners Across Government (PAG) and allies worldwide.

Increasingly, Aeronautical Information is required digitally, so No. 1 AIDU compiles data formats/images for specific uses. Around one million products per annum are printed externally and distributed to customers across the globe.

Since 1999, the unit has continually held a certificate of excellence from the British Standards Institute (BSI) for compliance with the ISO 9001 Quality Management Systems standard.

Based at RAF NORTHOLT in West London, No. 1 AIDU provides key mission support to various essential operations, solidifying its relevance in today's modern defence.
